Resolution 2608 (2021)

Provides authorisation inter alia for International naval forces to operate in territorial waters Extended only for 3 months

Follows representations by Federal Government of Somalia Based on no pirate attacks for some years

UN Contact group continues Probable impact on the deployment of EUNAVFOR

HRA definition

HRA defined in the BMP 5 and referenced in the Global Counter Piracy guidance

'A HRA is an industry defined area within the Voluntary Reporting Area where it is considered that a higher risk of attack exists, and additional security requirements may be necessary.'

Imperative to keep it up to date and reflect the threat. ICS, BIMCO, Intercargo, OCIMF and INTERTANKO

Separate from insurance


Significant reduction in all attacks in 2021 Similar reduction in K&R

Enhanced regional capabilities

Joint operational centres in Douala, Cotonou and Accra Enhanced surveillance (Yaris) Better regional cooperation SHADE GoG

Nigerian Deep Blue Nigerian Naval capability

Likely to have a reaffirmation of Yaoundé agreement to mark 10 years



International naval deployment from:

Italy, Spain, France, Portugal, the UK, the US, Brazil and Russia.

Notable interventions by Italy, Russia and Denmark

MDAT GoG working well

Very welcomed deployments

Need the anti piracy mandates

Better communications and relations with regional forces including legal finish

Need access to Yaris and Solarta

SHADE GoG will provide a good forum for exchange



Questions over appetite to maintain funding and mandates Indian Ocean took 10 years of sustained effort Unlikely to see similar arrangements

Revolves around on shore criminal and political situation Solution lies ashore Nigeria and the region are taking this very seriously

2021 has been positive, hopefully it will continue







Importance of shipping often forgotten by governments
